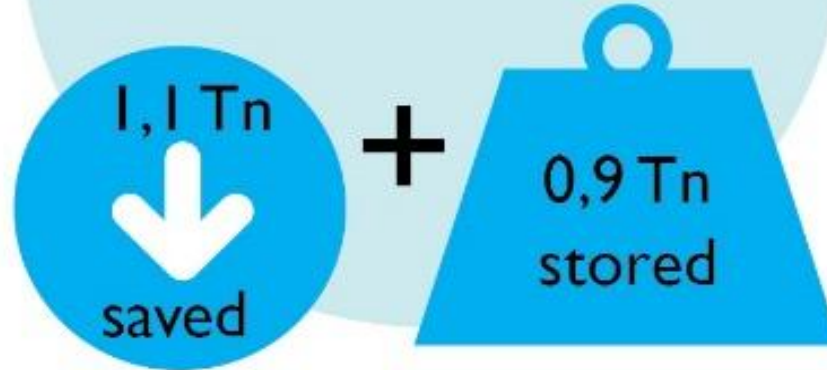

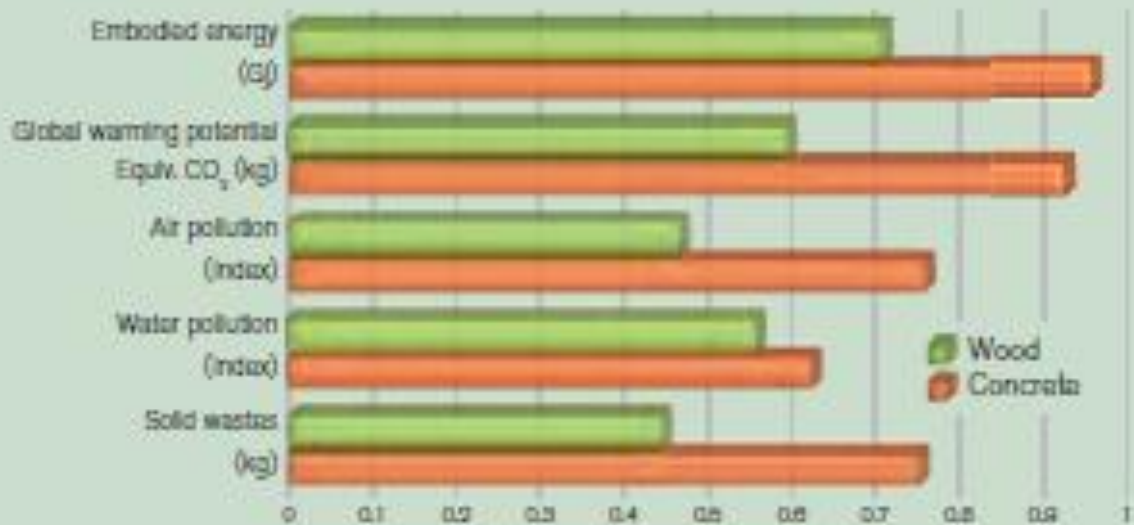
1 m<sup>3</sup> of wood as building material

### Environmental impacts of wood house vs concrete house

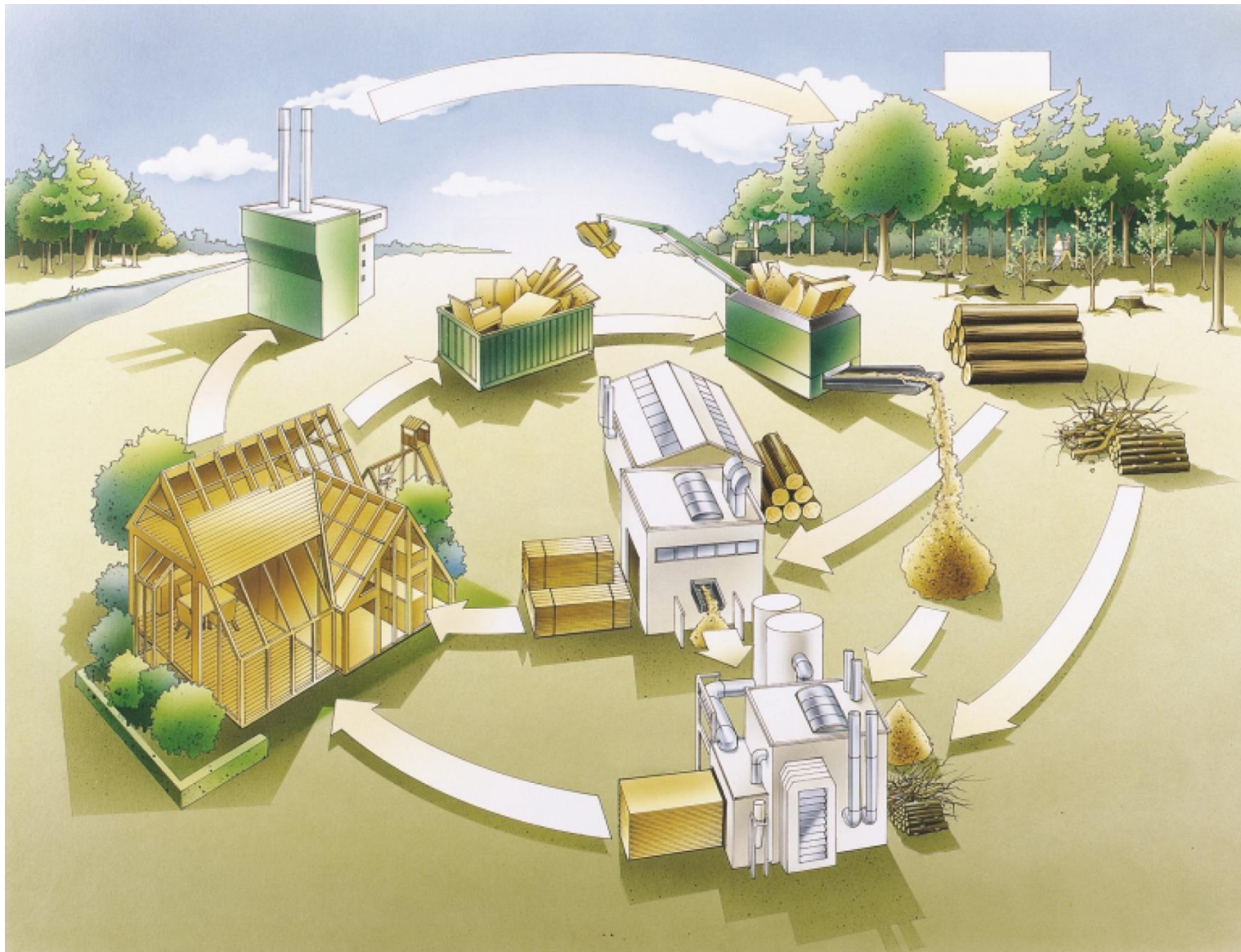






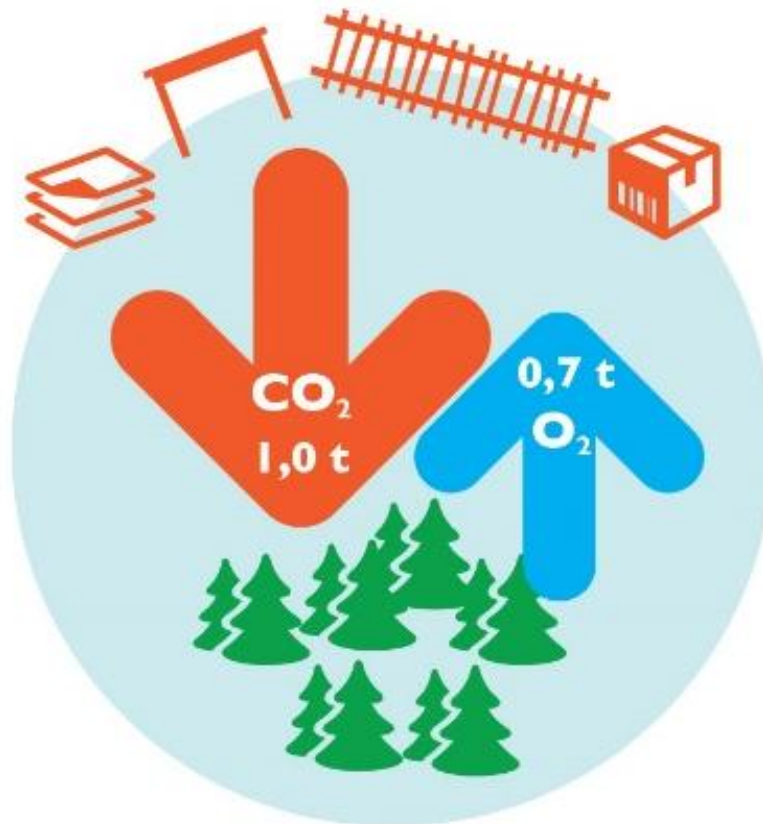








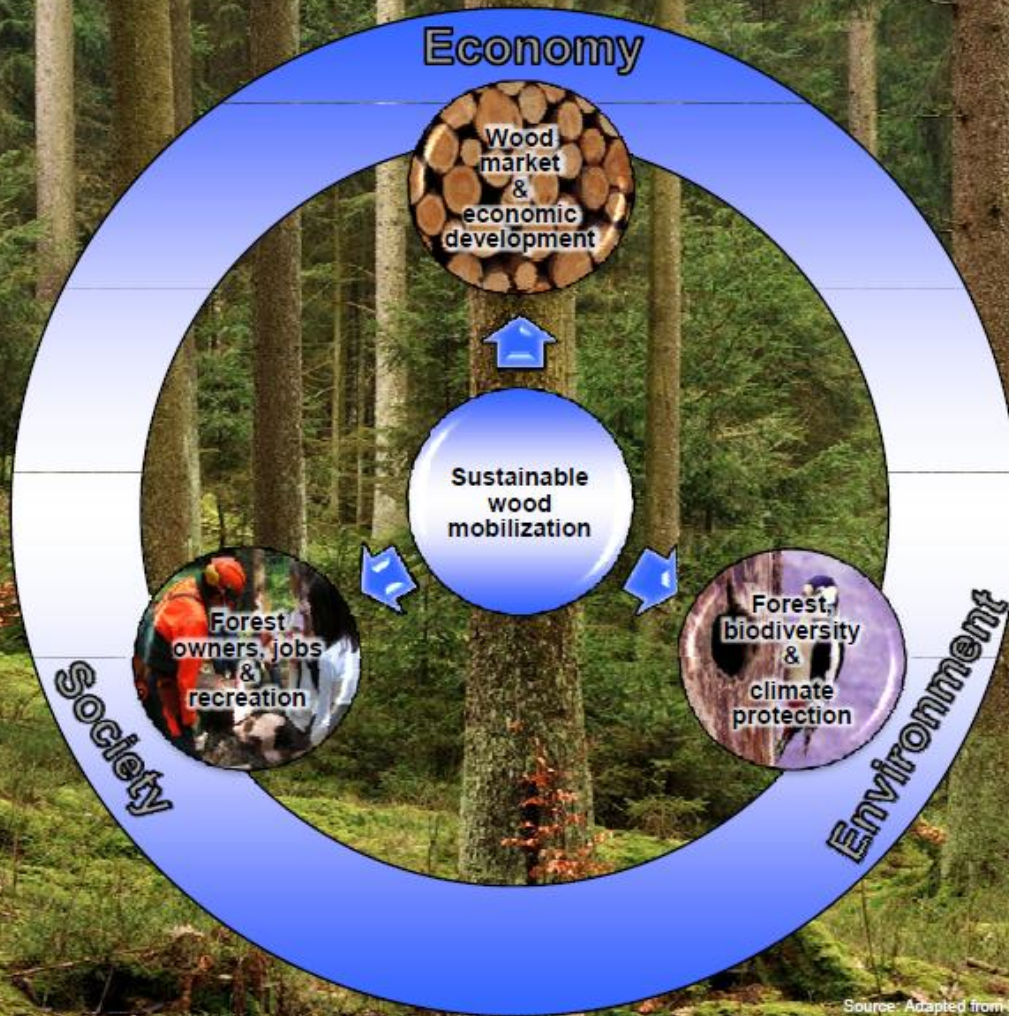
