

Why use tropical timber?

- If responsibly sourced wood is the only truly renewable material
- Sustainably produced tropical timber excels in durability, strrenght and high quality
- Avoiding the use of tropical timber is not a solution.
 Buying sustainably produced timber helps to conserve the remaining tropical forests
- Selectively logged production forests retain a large proportion of their production potential, biodiversity and carbon storage function

A strong united message is required







Action plans

- 1. First round individual action plans (app. 30)
- 2. Some examples of activities:
 - training of personnel
 - set ambitious targets on sourcing
 - set up monitoring and reporting mechanisms
 - development of procurement policies
 - support of sub-contractors on CoC-certification
 - communication towards clients and others
 - incorporate new lesser used timber species in sales







Working Groups of the European STTC

Communication and promotion:

- Develop communication strategy (improve image)

2. Business encounters:


